Each one of us is accountable for something within ourselves. We write our story each day and build a future moment by moment. Our goal is to teach confidence-building defense techniques while developing qualities such as self-control, focus, respect, integrity, and stamina.

Each week we focus on one of the six principles in becoming a black belt. These values include modesty, courtesy, integrity, self-control, perseverance, and indomitable spirit. Our three student creeds highlight these attitudes and are shared during each class. These philosophies cultivate opportunities to grow both mind and body while developing one’s ability to write a vision toward success.

Each TKD class is a thrill to instruct, and your young athletes are maneuvering very well. We have been striping belts for achievements in character and curriculum development. Orange stripes indicate positive ways of behaving while red, yellow, green, and blue are reserved for curriculum successes. A red stripe points out comprehension in poomse (form or pattern); a yellow stripe reveals knowledge in kicking; a green stripe points toward an understanding in kyorugi (sparring); while a blue stripe reveals an appreciation of hapkido (art of coordinated power).

We are the AJK Dragons. Korean dragons embody rich and positive wisdom, serenity, and justice. Together we represent strength and peace.
